**ORDER DENYING PLAINTIFF'S MOTION TO UNSEAL JOINT TRIAL EXHIBITS
ENTERED INTO EVIDENCE DURING PHASE I TRIAL ON JUNE 2-4, AND 8, 2010**

Upon consideration of Plaintiff the Official Committee of Unsecured Creditors' *Motion to Unseal Joint Trial Exhibits Entered Into Evidence During Phase I Trial on June 2-4, and 8, 2010* [Adversary Docket No. 112] (the "Motion to Unseal"), the responses to the Motion to Unseal, and the entire record of this adversary proceeding and the related chapter 11 case, it is hereby

ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED THAT:

1. The Motion to Unseal is **DENIED**.
2. As directed in the Court's March 10, 2010 Stipulated Order Governing the Production and Exchange of Confidential Information (the "Confidentiality Order"), the Official Committee of Unsecured Creditors shall either (a) destroy all Confidential Information (as that term is defined in the Confidentiality Order) or (b) return all Confidential Information, except for

court papers, deposition and trial transcripts and attorney work product, provided that it shall not disclose such materials to any other party, except pursuant to court order. This includes, but is not limited to, any Confidential Information contained in the joint trial exhibits entered into evidence during the Phase I trial on June 2-4, and 8, 2010.

3. *The Economist* is permitted to file a motion in the main case, Case No. 09-13560 (CSS), seeking relief relating to the joint trial exhibits entered into evidence during the Phase I trial on June 2-4, and 8, 2010.

4. In the event *The Economist* elects to file such a motion, the following schedule shall apply:

- a. The motion must be filed on or before February 8, 2012.
- b. Any response to the motion must be filed on or before February 16, 2012, at 12:00 p.m. (EST).
- c. The motion will be heard on February 21, 2012 at 10:00 a.m. (EST)

5. In the event no such motion is filed by *The Economist*, the Non-Debtor Defendants shall notify the Court of same.
