**ORDER**

Upon consideration of the Emergency Motion of the Official Committee of Unsecured Creditors to Hold Catholic Diocese of Wilmington, Inc. and other Parties in Civil Contempt for Violation of the Automatic Stay and Mediation Order and Request for Expedited Consideration Thereon [D.I. 354] filed on June 15, 2010 (the "Emergency Motion"). The Court having considered the Emergency Motion; the Court finding that (a) the Court has jurisdiction over the Emergency Motion under 28 U.S.C. § 1334; and (b) the Emergency Motion is a core proceeding under 28 U.S.C. § 157(b)(2); and the Court having determined that the movant has not established sufficient cause to justify the relief requested in the Emergency Motion.
